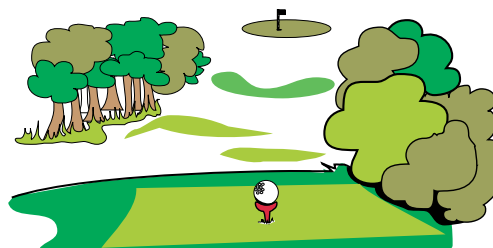

Buffy said that she has never received an award but she has achieved sobriety for three years. “The Club has helped me so much to keep working harder and now I feel that I can achieve anything in life.”

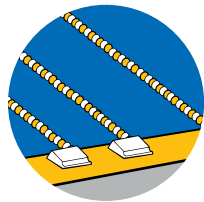
