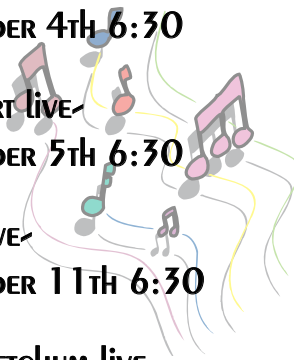



EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

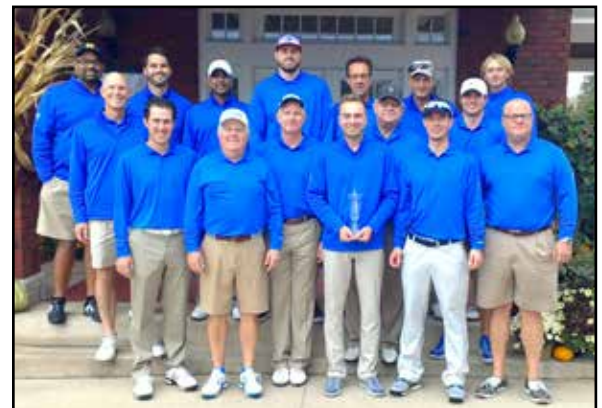
