# PAR for the course

by Gideon Smith, Head Golf Professional Spring is here and the course is open. The irrigation project is ahead of schedule and the course is greening up. As we head into the golf year, we would like you to please take a minute if you didn't get

the email to read the memo about our Cart Policy moving forward. As you are playing holes will be closed weekly for the irrigation project. We ask that you hand your scorecard in when you are done so we can post your scores correctly with the closed hole.

April brings the Masters Tournament, Demo Days and PGA Junior League Practice. It also brings greens and approaches aerification. This year we will be deep tining and sand injecting the greens. Our target date for this is April 22-24. Deep tining is less invasive than core aeri-

### **GOLF CART POLICY**

1. *Extra fee for single carts* - In an effort to minimize damage done by unnecessary cart usage on the course, we will assume double-ridership in golf carts (two carts per foursome). Should you choose to take single carts, there will be a wear-and-tear charge of a cart-and-a-half. (Currently that would mean \$30 per rider vs. \$20 per rider for double-ridership). This additional charge will not apply to single golfers, threesomes or fivesomes where one cart would contain a single rider.

2. *Follow the signs and staking* - Please respect and follow signs and staking and do not take carts where they are not allowed. All carts should be 20 yards away from greens and tees and staked-off areas are off-limits to carts. This is not a new policy, but it will be more actively enforced this year as we navigate construction on the course and allow time for the course to heal after the irrigation project is completed. If you require a medical exception, please see Gideon.

We have asked Gideon and Tim to give "gentle reminders" to anyone not following cart traffic directions. We understand the difficulty of breaking bad habits and assume that simple reminders are all that will be needed. If one or two "gentle reminders" aren't solving things, the offender will be referred to the board for further action.

April also brings women's and men's clinics. Women's Clinics in April will be listed on the golf calendar attached to the newsletter along with demo days and upcoming golf events. We have a new line coming into the Pro Shop and it is called Vuga. You will also see Greg Norman for ladies, FJ for ladies and Puma for men.
