Please let winter be over so that we can get the golf season started. Products are coming in daily to gear up for the upcoming golf season. The new Ping G410 family of woods and hybrids are in—the

new Ping forged wedges are in-the new TaylorMade M5 and M6 woods are in, along with the new TaylorMade golf ball. Something new and exciting to the Titleist family of golf balls is first the new ProV1 and ProV1x golf balls and introducing the ProV1 and ProV1x in YELLOW! That's right, a new yellow ProV1(x) golf ball. We have the new Ping Vault line of putters that are adjustable. With our new TaylorMade putting trainer, we can really dial you in for the proper putter and the work on your stroke. I have had the opportunity to play with the new TS driver from Titleist and it is fantastic. They thinned out the crown so they could help create faster ball speeds off the face of the driver. More ball speed equals more distance. New fashion pieces are coming in. We have to look good when we hit the course! We have both women's and men's fashions in the Pro Shop ready for spring.

• We would like to introduce the membership to the newest member of the our Pro Shop Staff, Chase Griffin. Chase is originally from Decatur, Illinois. He recently graduated from the Golf Career College in Dallas, Texas. Chase is excited to get started and should be here in the Shop around the 1st or 2nd week of March.

Because of a long and wet winter, we will need to closely monitor the condition of the course to determine if play is possible.

If you need another copy, please contact the Pro Shop and I will email it to you. We have made a couple of changes to the schedule for the irrigation project and we will continue to remind members.

• When the irrigation project is going on, the workers will be closing one hole each day, Monday through Thursday. You will still be able to post your score. The Pro Shop is asking that you turn in your scorecard after your rounds so we can post your scores for you. You will receive your handicap on the closed hole. (Example: If #12 is closed and it is the 12 handicap hole and you have a 10 handicap, you will take par on that hole. If you have a 13 handicap, you will take a net bogey on the hole for score posting purposes.)

The Pro Shop will constantly be in communication with members telling them of course conditions and what hole will be closed for the day. There will be no holes closed Friday through Sunday during the project.

Have a great month of March. We look forward to working with you on your golf game as we kick-start the spring golf season. Check with the Pro Shop and find out about our lesson packages for the year.
