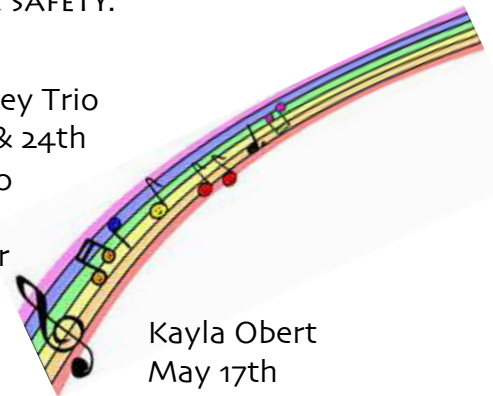
WOMEN'S SUMMER BRIDGE

It is hard to believe that it is May already. April flew by and the weather was typical spring weather. We covered all phases with snow on Master's Sunday, timely rain, cool temps and warm temps. It has been a late start to the golf year but we have seen a larger amount of golfers at the Club. The good thing is the irrigation project is 30 days ahead of schedule and they are flying through the course.

We have some new events for the 2019 season. The first is Senior Fridays. What is this you ask? For players who are 55 and older, we are setting up a bi-weekly game for you. The entry fee per week is \$5 and it is open for men and women. You can make your own groups and play at your own times. Formats will be posted on a schedule and you can play any tee.
