PAR for the course

March is upon us and that means new products are arriving. It also means that hopefully, after a mid-size winter, we are able to dust off the clubs and head back to the course. 2021 brings hope that we will be moving

forward and leaving 2020 in our rearview mirror. It also brought about "best practices" that we can use on and off the course.

This is again a new year for gear! For all you Ping enthusiasts, the new G425 family of woods is out. They are in your Pro Shop and we are ready to fit you. They look really good, and once again, Ping has perfected long and STRAIGHT. Also you will see that TaylorMade has come out with the Sim2 family of woods and irons. As a TaylorMade staff member, I wonder how such a good product like the SIM can be improved. My indoor testing proved that with the same shaft set up and loft, the SIM2 carries in the air 4-5 yards further and the ball speeds were up 4-5 mph compared to my 2020 SIM driver. More distance with the same accuracy means one half a club less when approaching the green and hopefully a few feet closer to the hole. Titleist has a new TSi series of woods. Once again, the big push in 2021 is faster ball speeds and Titleist has accomplished this in comparison to the last TS series models.

The iron market has a few changes as well. You will

see a new SIM2 iron, the Ping G425 iron and the Mizuno JPX921 models. These 3 iron companies will be a big portion of our iron sales. The JPX lineup of irons is really good, buttery soft with large amounts of forgiveness—how can you go wrong. Ping with the G lineup of irons is always a big seller and TaylorMade's improvements to the SIM lineup of irons make game improvement for more player categories really strong.

Player irons will be dominated by Mizuno MP forgings and the TaylorMade 7 series. We will be busy fitting on the range this year. The launch monitor we purchased last year makes fitting so streamlined and easy. We will have a new piece of equipment for every player.

Last, a new apparel product line you will see in June of 2021 is Johnnie-O. They make a great product for both on and off the course. Vineyard Vines will be good, Footjoy is always good, and we will continue with a small grouping of Matte Grey and Greg Norman. We are excited for the season to get started and to put new products in your hands.

Make sure to sign up for the 2-person St. Patrick's Day event being held on March 20th. Shotgun start at 11 a.m. You can sign up with another member, family member, or guest. The format will be a 2-person scramble and the event will be flighted.

Spring is close and we are excited to be getting onto the course.

Restore Illinois Covid Update

Phase 4 Guidance

As of Monday January 18th, Governor Pritzker has moved region 3 back to Phase 4. This is great news for QCC as this phase allows for indoor dining.

I have listed below the main points. As always, please be safe as you enter and leave the QCC campus.

Minimum guidelines

- 1. Area capacity should be determined by arranging seating to provide a minimum of six feet between tables or other designated patron service areas.
- 2. Maximum occupancy of 25% of standing area capacity. 3. 10-person party limit.
- 3. Configure space to allow for at least 6-ft. of distance between tables or other designated patron service areas; if tables/ booths cannot be moved, employers should only use every other table/ booth to allow for separation between patrons of unrelated parties. Bar seating should be spaced 6-ft apart to maintain social distancing between patrons of unrelated parties.
- 4. To the extent possible, patrons should wait for services off premises, either outdoors and maintaining social distance of 6-ft with use of recommended face coverings or in their vehicles. Patrons can wait in waiting area but should adhere to 6-ft distancing guidelines.
- 5. Hotel meeting rooms and ballrooms, as well as other indoor and outdoor event venues. Arenas, stadiums, and other spectator venues should follow Outdoor Seated Spectator Events guidelines. Note: organizations that operate across multiple workplace environments should refer to applicable Phase IV guidelines for guidance on those workplaces

Note: As of release, meetings and social events are limited to lesser of 50 guests OR 50% of overall room capacity. Capacity restrictions will be reassessed based on the latest science and public health metrics on an ongoing basis throughout Phase IV.
