PAR for the course

July is Championship month. Every category of player has a Championship in the month of July. Even though the word “Championship” is in the title it doesn’t mean that the event is not for you. The word “Championship” doesn’t eliminate the membership and only scream good player. There is a category in every event for all players. Yes, we will crown an overall champion but there are flight winners as well. Each flight is created by handicap, so you are playing with a similar caliber player. So as the sign-ups go up we hope that you consider to play in Club Championships this July.

Sign-ups are open for the Men’s Member – Guest Invitational that is held in September. The dates for the event are September 16-18. Congratulations goes out to our Women’s CICCAs team who won the team gross portion. Also congratulations to Lizzy Klingner who won the individual title. The team consisted of: Pam Rein, Lizzy Klingner, Allison Hall, D’Aunn Sturhahn, Vicki Hayden (CICCA Rep), Shannon Nicholas, Kandi Ehrhart and Denette Kuhlman.

The course has held up great through an early heat spell. Tim and his crew are doing an amazing job through the heat. As we head into the summer months, we ask that you abide by cart policies.

Carting Smart, Safe Fun and Our Course initiatives:

- Keep carts 15-20 yards from tee complexes and greens. It is just habit to drive up close to the green complexes but we are asking you to be mindful and keep your distance.
- If ropes or stakes are up, that doesn’t mean drive through or around them and go into those areas. You will be seeing us protect the course and turf a lot in the heat of the summer. So please continue doing a great job of staying out of those areas.
- If you have a medical condition and you need to get closer to the tee box or greens please let the Pro Shop staff know.
- The new carts are speedy so that means we have to be extra careful around the pool area, in front of the Pro Shop and going down the hill on #13. It also means that new carts have new tires with sharp treads. The tighter the turn you make in the fairway the better chance you have of tearing up turf.
- Last, as it gets hotter please consider using the sand and seed provided on the carts if your divot isn’t replaceable.

Have a great month of July, look into signing up for Championships that fit your category and for all of our families, we hope you join us for the **FAMILY OLYMPICS** on July 24th.
