We are fresh back from the PGA Merchandise Show in Orlando, Florida. We were able to play a few rounds with some members and enjoy some moderately warmer temps than at home. So all three of us, Emily, Jon, and I, were able to hit the TaylorMade Stealth driver while we were in South Florida. The reviews from the team were very positive. It feels great—the ball flight was really good and distance off the tee was good. Emily hit the driver and gained some substantial distance off the tee from her past TaylorMade driver. Jon for sure hit it further, but needed a different loft versus the 9 degree he tried. I think after watching players hit the driver, they will be purchasing higher lofts than in past years. The Carbon face doesn't feel soft and the ball comes off faster. We look forward to warm weather and fitting members with this great product. The new TaylorMade wedges are in as well—they for sure produce more spin with the micro groove that has been inserted on the face. The wedge has a clean shape and really good turf contact. Many of the big vendors pulled out of the Merchandise Show this year, but that gave us a great chance to research and look at new vendors that we may not have had time to visit in the past. We found a women's fashion company that makes great sun products. We will see those products arrive in early summer when the temps warm up. UnderAmour was really good looking as was Dunning. The summer pieces and outerwear pieces will be good. Even though the Show was smaller and there were less people attending, it still was good to network and meet new people.
