As we approach the month of March, we are hopeful that we can start to dust some rust off and head to the course or the range. We have actually had some snow cover this year and that is always good for the course. As we start to move into springtime temps, golf programs start to begin.

We had a successful Indoor Putt-Putt event with 29 couples participating in the event. Congratulations to Parker & Whitney Freiburg for being the low scoring couple. Our next big event will be the St. Patrick's Day 2-person scramble. This event is open to men and women. The event date will be March 19th and it will be an 11 a.m. shotgun start. Members can invite a guest if they would like, play with a spouse, or with another member. Sign-ups will be done online for this event. We ask that you check your email for the link. If you do not have a profile created in Golf Genius, the Pro Shop can assist you.


New products have started to come into the Pro Shop. The new TaylorMade Stealth driver, fairways and hybrids are in the Pro Shop. The Stealth Driver has the new Carbon face that is 20% lighter than a titanium face. This means that you can move weight around in the head to make it more forgiving (good for most of us) and able to create optimal launch and spin conditions. After playing with the driver, I was extremely happy with the performance. We have already started fitting the Club indoors and we look forward to heading outdoors with more fittings. The new SM9 Vokey wedges are in the Pro Shop and we are ready to fit people along with the new MG3 TaylorMade wedges. Both wedges look good and will help you on the course.

Our new Footjoy lineup of shoes, gloves and apparel should be in quickly. We always want to start the season off looking good, wearing great footwear and feeling good about ourselves before we head to the course. Stop by and check out the new fashions that will be coming into the Pro Shop.

PGA Junior League signups are open. Parents should start to see email going out and links to sign your juniors up for Junior League. Practices will begin in April and League play starts in June. The age limits for Junior League will be 7-13 years of age. This is a great program for junior players and we look forward to another successful Junior League season.
