The month of March was a really slow start for the golf industry in our area. Between rain, snow, and cool temps we didn't have a busy month of golf. There is new merchandise in the Pro Shop and much more is coming throughout April.

So what is planned for April? April 10th - 12th is the **Quincy University Hawk's Home Tournament at the Club**. We will have a few teams coming in the afternoon of the 10th to play their practice rounds. The course will be open for member play but we have times reserved for teams from 12:30 - 2:00 p.m. on the 10th. The course will be closed for member play on Monday, April 11th. Tuesday, April 12th, the course will be closed in the

morning and early afternoon for a 9:00 a.m. shotgun start and will open for member play around 2:00 p.m. when the teams have finished. Both the men's and women's teams have been playing well this spring and we wish them good luck at their home event.

In April we have scheduled 4 Fitting Days at the Club. We ask that you set up an appointment so that our reps can spend some quality time to fit you for the proper product. If you can't make a date, please contact your PGA Professional staff to set up a personal fitting. We have all the gear and the launch monitor to make sure we get the best product in your hand. I feel Wedge fittings are one of the most important things you can do. Please contact the Pro-Shop to set up a wedge fitting. Save strokes and get fit properly for wedges.

May 4th we will be hosting the Women's Opening Day Scramble at the Club. It will be an ABCD Scramble with lunch to follow golf. The start time is 9 a.m. and you can sign up in the Pro Shop.

May 7th (Saturday) will be the **Men's Opening Day** event. It will be 4 person teams and we will shotgun start at 10:30 a.m. The format will be 1 net ball of the 4 on par 5's, 2 net balls on par 4's and 3 net balls on par 3's. Sign your foursome up in the Pro Shop or on the emailed out golf genius link. Please contact the Pro Shop to receive the link if you haven't already.

May 10th, Tuesday Night League begins. If you are interested in playing in the League there is still time to sign up. A team is made up of 2 members and you play against all the other teams within the league. Playoffs begin in August and the last 2 person team standing is our League Champions. Contact the Pro Shop for more details.

May 20th is "**Member Appreciation Day**" at the Club. Members can bring up to 3 guests to the Club that day with no Guest Fees. We will serve lunch from 11 a.m. -2 p.m. and you can play in the morning and have lunch, have lunch and play afterwards, or have lunch at the turn. This will not count towards the Guest 5 time rule for the year. Contact the Pro Shop to sign up. Also, please contact the Pro Shop for the cost. Member Appreciation Day includes a tee gift for guests, lunch for everyone, and carts for the group.

We have many more items in the month of May. You can check the Club website under golf for the calendar. We also have on the website our instruction rates for golf lessons. We plan to add new swing tip videos and sign-ups for events.

To our female members of the Club—want to learn to play golf but are hesitant to start. A new Player Development Program is for you and a female member/friend. Sign up to take lessons together. The golf lesson program will start at the beginning of May and go through mid to late August. Check the details in the Pro Shop. This is a great opportunity for you and your friend to get better at golf. Make golf your thing!

Last, the **Member – Guest Invitational** will be held **September 15th – 17th**. Sign-ups will begin on May 1st and close on September 1st. The field will be limited to the first 48 teams that sign-up; then a wait list will start. There will be a new format for the Invitational. We will be switching to match play within flights versus stroke play. Each team will play a match against everyone in their flight. The link will be emailed out just before May 1st. We will also include the link in the May newsletter. The format change will be exciting and will create some great competition to determine who our overall Champions will be for the 2022 event.
