In the last Newsletter that goes out on Saturdays, there was a misprint for Guest Rounds played and Rounds for Social Members of the Club. A Guest or a Social Member of the Club is only allowed 5 rounds at the Club. Page 13 of the member handbook lists the following items for Guest Play.

**“A regular member may bring up to 7 guests at any of the appropriate times. However, an organization may not be represented by a group of members to accommodate a larger number of golfers. In such a case, specific authorization by the Board of Directors is necessary. A Social Member may play golf up to (5) five times a year and may play with up to (3) three guests during any of those rounds. A Social Member may not sponsor unaccompanied guests. Regular guest fees shall apply to all rounds played by social members and their guests. A guest is defined as any person who is NOT a member of the Quincy Country Club. All guests must be registered in the Pro Shop. All golfing guests are subject to the five (5) time guest rule.”**

**Sport Division**

The Sport Division is for the junior that can manage their way around 1-2 holes at a time. Clinic days are very hands on getting players familiar with the basics of the golf swing and fundamentals of playing the game
